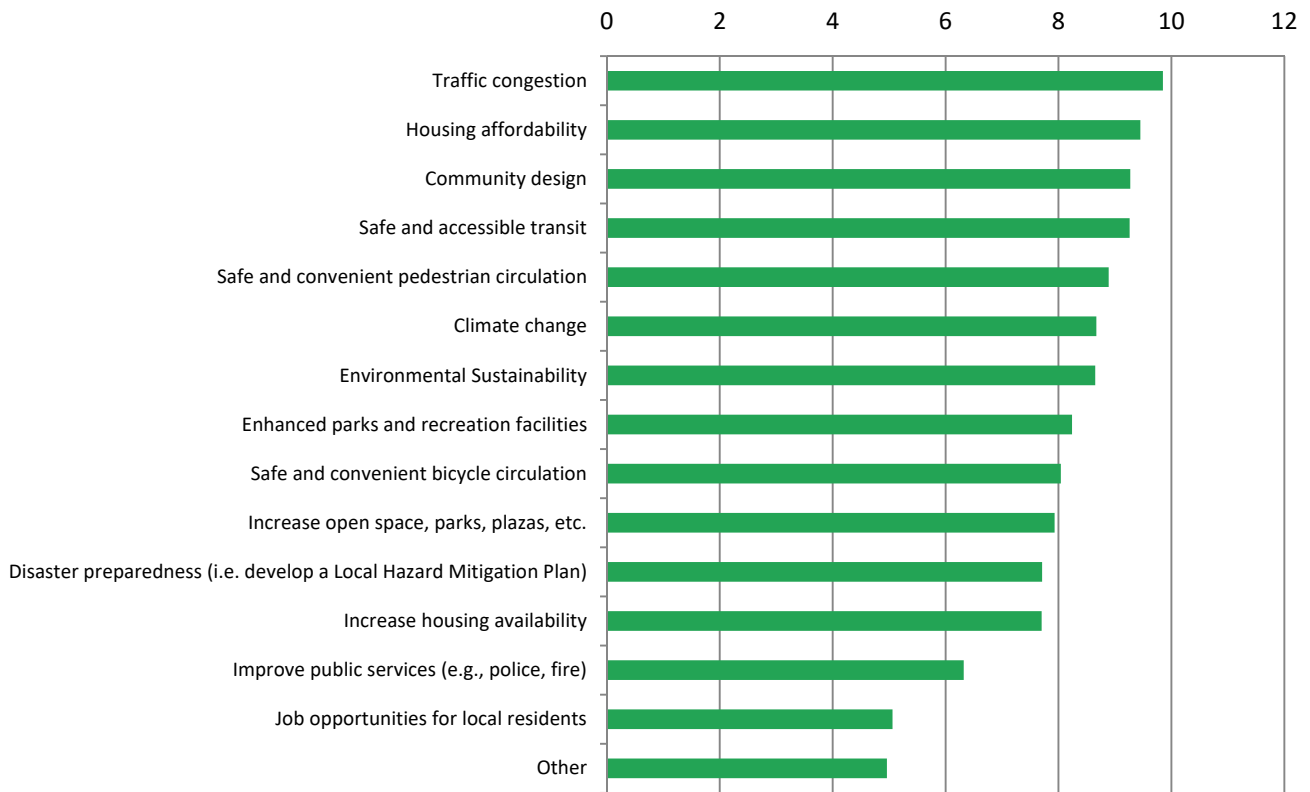


San Mateo General Plan 2040 Ranking Exercise Results
