There are a number of socio-economic status data points that I think San Mateo could consider including:

- Origin (Native Born, Foreign Born)
- Households
- School Enrollment
- Educational Attainment
- Language spoken at home
- Class of Worker
- Income

There are also strong data sets for housing that I hope we could include, though I realize that the Housing Element isn't part of our scope:

- Housing Occupancy
- Units in Structure
- Year Structure Built
- Bedrooms
- Housing Tenure
- Value
- Mortgage
- Selected Monthly Owner Costs
- Gross Rent

Also displaying the land-use distribution and parks in a chart form makes it easy to digest.
