Hi Tim,

One piece of insight I received yesterday for your consideration at today's meeting. Caltrain is meeting with each City to review their future service plans as a part of the Caltrain Business Plan (we setting up and a part of the meetings as well). San Mateo's meeting is scheduled for a few weeks (April 9th I think) but only the PW director and another PW staff are scheduled to attend. Most other City's are sending City managers, Planning directors, and/or City councilmembers. I think it would be important for Kohar and others to attend given the importance of these plans to their General Plan and the fact they have among the most stations in their City. So if it makes sense, you may want to subtly bring this up during your meeting today. Under the proposed service plans, Hillsdale will of course have the highest service in the future of any of the three San Mateo stations, and therefore is primed for the transit hub we are developing. We will be following up on our end as well through our Caltrain Business Plan team to mention that most City's send a diverse group of City leaders.
