We live at [REDACTED] and have done so for the past 30 years. While I was raised in the Hillsdale Garden Apartments it was with great delight when my family was finally able to move from a heavily congested multi unit area. The parking was terrible as well as the quality of life. At that time the Hillsdale Garden Apartments had waiting lists for occupancy and there were strict guidelines for all residents, adults as well as children.

Now that I see the misguided push for additional housing coming into play I must share my disappointment with the City authorities. You cannot continue to squeeze people into places where it's simply not feasible. In our area I'm aware of several residents who are renting out rooms in their homes. This not only has affected the neighborhood quality of life but it is also lowering the property values.
