I am unable to attend this evening's City Council meeting but I wanted to express my concern about any consideration of changing the zoning of any residential neighborhood.

Measure P identifies neighborhoods suitable for high density housing and establishes height limits up to 75 feet. Updates to Measure P to provide additional density may be in order. This does not justify rezoning R1 neighborhoods for multifamily.

Communities everywhere are under pressure to create additional housing.

San Mateo has done MORE THAN ITS SHARE to provide additional housing. The present zoning and residential development policies do not require change.
