As a carpenter, you paid your dues to get what you needed. The development promoters want to dictate terms to get what they want. Many development proposals seem to require removal and replacement of San Mateo residents who have paid their dues.

Caltrain's moderate growth forecast is 100 new daily riders from the city of San Mateo will be added to the system. Since 3,000 to 5,000 new residents will arrive for existing housing approvals, how will the other 2,900 to 4,900 residents, transportation needs be met? Sustainable growth is desirable but needs to occur in small increments.

Eliminating parking requirements and narrowing streets is not a sustainable growth plan. My neighborhood has no viable transit options. I cannot get to my work location via public transit.
