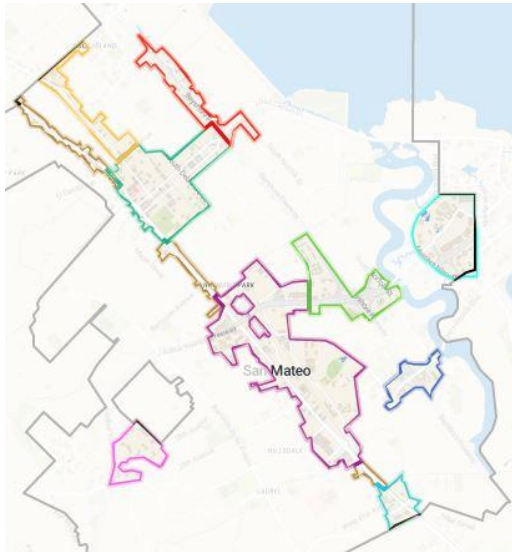
Strive San Mateo 2040 General Plan
