












A Specific Plan is a customized plan that describes policies and regulations for specific geographic areas of the city.







Each **General Plan Meeting Series** will include some combination of community workshops and events, General Plan Subcommittee meetings, Planning Commission study sessions, and City Council direction.




Housing Element Outreach includes stakeholder meetings, community meetings, Planning Commission hearings, and City Council hearings.

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Future Steps: Technical Evaluation

- » Determine and evaluate preferred Land Use Scenario
- » Technical evaluation will consider things like:
 - Amount of development hat would be allowed
 - Overall character
 - Traffic impacts
 - Public health
 - Potential displacement
 - Impacts on utilities and public services
 - Environmental sustainability
 - City's fiscal health
 - Potential community benefits
 - Development feasibility
 - Applicable State laws/regulations
- » No decisions on a preferred land use scenario will be made until evaluation is complete <u>and</u> shared with the community.
