I went through the full set of documents, vision statements etc. there is ample mention of the next generation, but hardly any mention of education. The single biggest contributor of success when looking at the future is very high quality education. The school districts for 94402 and 94403 zip codes have been ranked bad at GreatSchools. With the exception of Aragob, Hillsdale high and George Hall (7-8 range), the rest of the schools are below 6. If we have to improve San Mateo, we have to make this one of the top 3 priorities along with business growth and residential safety. It is definitely hard to see very little focus on Education and improving the quality of education in the General Plan.
