I went to a General Plan workshop early on and have been lightly following the process since then.

I believe we need to expand the study areas, and at least consider all parcels that are within a half-mile of the train stations. Intentionally excluding single-family neighborhoods from the study areas means lower-income neighborhoods will see the most change, which will perpetuate segregation and inequity.
