In regards to Measure Y - we support updating Measure Y or placing it on the ballot.

As we live on Louise Lane and Edison Street, our support for changes to Measure Y is purely selfish - the reason being is we want the lowest height buildings as new housing along Edison Street as proposed by Bohannon for the Hillsdale Shopping Center.

However we will say it is unfortunate this measure does not protect residential neighborhoods from having a developer build a 7 - 10 story building right next to single family homes, destroying the integrity of the neighborhoods. It is fine to allow 7-10 stories housing along El Camino Real, but to allow it to encroach on residential neighborhoods is a shame.

El Camino Real is just a way to get up and down the Peninsula. Nobody takes it for the beauty of it - they take it for the function of it. That is where the housing with height should be allowed and placed - along El Camino Real - not in residential areas along single family homes. I am sure where you live - you would not want a 7-12 story building built next door to you.
