**Subject:** 25th Avenue - Land Use and Heights

Attention Council Members,

As a life long member of the 25th Ave. community (20 years on 23rd Ave, 50 years at 24th & Isabelle), I am whole heartedly opposed to a proposal to change land use designations, specifically, raising building height requirements to include the church parking lot at 25th Ave. and Hacienda. I am opposed to a development of this size which does not reflect the single-family residences in our surrounding area.

In a shared response from a neighbor. Councilmember Loraine stated, "The proposal to change these and other *land use designations*, for *possible* future development citywide, is part of the ongoing General Plan Update process. The city has had dozens of public meetings and workshops for this over four years (and more to come this year).
