We are residents of Central San Mateo and would like to emphasize that the Draft General Plan does not provide enough protection for our neighborhood in regards to Circulation Elements:

- Protection of the classification of 5th & 9th Avenues and NOT to reclassifying them as Arterials. They are two of the main neighborhood streets in Central and should be protected as such.
- Our neighborhood requires an interim plan for increased traffic due to Kiku garage and <u>many</u> planned future projects in the immediate vicinity.
- We are requesting further traffic calming measures be instituted now and to not lose the stop signs or traffic circles currently in place.
- Increased parking on our neighborhood streets is an issue anywhere there is not a 2-hour limit. A simplified Residential Parking Permit Program is needed.
